**STANDING ORDER REGARDING JUDGMENT ON THE PLEADINGS IN
UNCONTESTED DIVORCES**

Upon written motion, the Court will grant a divorce decree upon the pleadings in uncontested cases when the motion sets out and the Clerk's file supports the following:


1. The written consent of both parties to a hearing any time 31 days after service or filing acknowledgment of service and the waiver of all further notice and right to a jury trial;
2. That neither the Department of Family and Children Services nor the Department of Human Services Division of Child Support Services has a right to intervene in the case;
3. That the parties have entered into a written agreement, duly witnessed, resolving all issues of child custody, child support, alimony, equitable distribution of property, and division of debt. If there are neither minor children nor property to be divided, that the party in possession of the property is entitled to ownership;
4. If child support is ordered, either an income deduction order through the Family Support Registry or a written agreement between the parties to an alternative payment arrangement;
5. If child support is ordered, that it follows the statutory guidelines, accompanied supporting worksheets and schedules, including all necessary findings of fact to support any deviations from the presumptive amount;
6. When custody of minor children is involved, compliance with the Court's Standing Order on Parenting Seminar in Divorce Cases;
7. That the attorney signing the motion certifies to the Court that the parties are entitled to judgment on the pleadings and any statements in the pleadings shall be deemed admissions in judicio.
