

HOW DO I RETURN MY ABSENTEE BALLOT?

Voters should mail or return their voted ballots on or before October 26 to ensure a timely delivery to be counted.

Here are ways available to voters to deliver their ballots:

- United States Postal Service
- Designated Ballot Drop Boxes located at the Watson Government Complex and at Hiram City Hall
- Hand deliver to the Election Office

How Do I Know I Have Received The Correct Absentee Ballot For My District?

All voters are assigned to polling locations and political districts. It is important that you do your homework and know the political representatives where you live.

In Paulding County we have:

One U.S. Congressional District which is 14

Two United States Senators

Two State Senate Districts which are 30 and 31

Four State House of Representative Districts which are 17, 19, 66, and 67

Four Post Commissioner Districts which are 1,2,3, and 4

There are six School Board Districts and one At Large seat that are ALL voted on at large by all of the voters in Paulding County.

We live in the Paulding County Judicial Circuit.
