

VOTER REGISTRATION

Voters must be registered by Monday, October 5, 2020 to vote in the November 3, 2020 General Election. If you are not sure if you are registered please visit www.mvp.sos.ga.gov

Ways to Register

Online:

Visit www.mvp.sos.ga.gov. You must have a valid Georgia Driver's License to use this service. Once you have submitted your registration, it will arrive on our County Election Dashboard the next morning for processing.

Paper Application:

Voter Registration Applications are available in the Election Office, the Tax Commissioners Office, the Tax Assessors Office, most County libraries, municipalities, and public assistance agencies.

Voter Registration Card (Precinct Card)

Once you are registered to vote by the Election Office staff, you will be issued a voter registration card/precinct card. You will receive this card four to six weeks after you register. Voters are encouraged to verify that the information on their card is correct. Please contact the Election Office with any questions or to request a replacement registration card.

Your registration card is to inform you of your polling location and your political districts. **YOU DO NOT HAVE TO HAVE THIS CARD TO VOTE.**

IMPORTANT:

Please keep your voter registration up to date. If you move, or change your name, you must notify us immediately. Should you move to another County or State, you must register in that County or State. **YOUR VOTER REGISTRATION DOES NOT FOLLOW YOU. YOU MAY ONLY REGISTER TO VOTE IN ONE STATE. YOU CANNOT HAVE MULTIPLE REGISTRATIONS. VOTING TWICE IS AN OFFENSE PUNISHABLE BY LAW.**
