STANDING ORDER ON INJUNCTIVE RELIEF IN DOMESTIC RELATIONS CASES

All parties in each domestic relations action, including any action for divorce, equitable division of assets and liabilities, child custody, child support, legitimation, annulment, determination of paternity, termination of parental rights in connection with an adoption proceeding filed in a superior court, any contempt proceeding relating to enforcement of a decree or order, a petition in respect to modification of a decree or order, an action on a foreign judgment based on alimony or child support, and adoption, are, upon notice:

Enjoined and restrained from unilaterally causing or permitting the minor child or children of the parties to be removed from the jurisdiction of the court without the permission of the court, except in an emergency which has been created by the other party to the action;

Enjoined and restrained from interfering with the custodial status of the minor children as it was at the time of separation or the right of the parent who had been the primary provider of care for said children from continuing to have custody until further order, and preventing reasonable visitation or contact between any of said children and the noncustodial parent;

Enjoined and restrained from doing or attempting to do or threatening to do any act which injures, maltreats, vilifies, molests, or harasses or which may, upon judicial determination, constitute threats, harassment, or stalking the adverse party or the child or children of the parties or any act which constitutes a violation of other civil or criminal laws of this state;

Enjoined and restrained from selling, encumbering, trading, contracting to sell, or otherwise disposing of or removing from the jurisdiction of the court, without the permission of the court, any of the property belonging to the parties except in the ordinary course of business or except in an emergency which has been created by the other party to the action; and

Enjoined and restrained from disconnecting or having disconnected the home utilities, changing or having changed and/or canceling or having canceled auto, health or life insurance for the parties or their children.



The injunctive relief granted herein binds the parties, their agents, servants, and employees, and all other persons acting in concert with the parties.


