House Bill 344
Act No. 149

"Shall the Act be approved which provides an exemption
from ad valorem taxes for all real property owned by a
purely public charity, if such charity is exempt from
taxation under Section 501(c) (3) of the Federal Internal
Revenue Code and such real property is held exclusively
for the purpose of building or repairing single-family
homes to be financed by such charity to individuals using
loans that shall not bear interest?"
